Pastor's Report

Pastor Laura reported she will be taking a week of vacation in July, and a week combined with continuing education in August. Supply pastors have already been arranged. She is currently not planning any long term goals as the call committee is progressing with their search.

Previous Business

The call committee has submitted the church's ministry profile; no one is aware of any candidates at this time. It was discussed to apply to the Endowment Committee to create a new internal fund of \$2000 for interviewing and hosting pastoral candidates. Any money leftover would be added to the New Pastor Reception Fund.

There are a few changes that impact who can go on the ASP trip and the cost.




Second, we are discussing a reduction in the cost if a youth commits early, I am not sure what that reduction might be for sure, but will find out more details in the weeks ahead.

Endowment Fund Notice of Request for Grants

As of September 1st, 2023, the Endowment Committee is posting grant applications for monies available from the Endowment Fund account held by our church. A total of up to \$24,223 will be dispersed. The breakdown of the allocation is as follows:

\$3,884 for Benziger Christian Education purposes
\$1,375 for Unrestricted General fund purposes.
\$10,570 for Mitchell Christian Education purposes
\$2,643 for Mitchell Operating Expenses purposes
\$5,750 for Higgins Unrestricted expenses
