The zoom meeting was called to order by Council President Ryan Smarsh at 6:40 p.m. and opened with a reading and prayer.

Chuck Heindrichs reported that \$23,000 from the ERC Fund was added to the income for November. Approximately \$9,000 is left in the ERC Fund and will be applied to income at the end of December.

It should also be noted that the \$31,623 withdrawal from the External Funds have not been posted on the account, as the balances show "as of 10/30/2023." This withdrawal has also added three new line items in the Internal Funds. Chuck also discussed the Organ Fund reserve has approximately \$1100 and should it be sent to pay down on the principal. It was decided to wait until the end of the year before sending in an extra payment.

Property

Tim Gottshall was absent; therefore, his report was received as written. It was noted that the snow removal was a fixed rate this year, and Chuck will follow up on specific dates of when the contract begins for future reference.

Pastor's Report

Pastor Laura reported the Preschool Board has been very busy. She was pleased that most of the members showed up for the wrapping of presents during the Preschool's Information Night. An invitation will be going out to the congregation soon to meet with the hired consultant regarding the vision for the Preschool and the Preschool Director position. Pastor Laura also inquired about the New Member Protocol, as well as discussed the Fall Congregation Meeting.

New Business

The Call Committee has had three interviews and is beginning in person interviews this week. After the Call Committee presents their chosen candidate to the Council, a special meeting will be held to introduce him/her to the congregation. There will be no sermon, just a meet and greet.

Eric is planning to perform the audit of the budget at the end of January.

The Solar Eclipse Committee has been formed and their first meeting will be early January.
