

Call Committee Update

The On Wednesday, September 6, our Call Committee met with Pastor Mitch Phillips, Assistant to the Bishop, for interview training. As a result, the Call Committee is preparing a plan of pertinent questions for first interviews of candidates. The hope is to have a practice interview by October 1st with a rostered pastor who will help shape the proposed interview plan and questions as need be. Meanwhile, Pastor Mitch is reviewing rostered ministers' mobility papers. He will contact candidates who seem to have the best gifts for our faith community as the Holy Spirit guides. It is projected that we will begin interviewing candidates in October.

It was emphasized that we are *calling* a pastor, which is different than *hiring* a candidate as would a business. All involved in the call process, including our members, must be aware of the work of the Holy Spirit, as we continue to discern what God is working out for us. To do otherwise is to risk that we will not have the pastor our congregation needs at this time. Please continue to be united in prayer, asking for God's direction as the call process continues. May God's will be done.

Pastor's Report

Pastor Laura reported that Adult Sunday School has started and the first session went really well. She also reported that Synod will be offering Lay Ministry classes and will be getting more information out to the congregation for those who would be interested.

Previous Business

There is \$23,000 available for the Endowment grants this year. Applications are due by October.

Council has decided to ask for \$2,000 for pastoral interviews and travel expenses, with the remainder of the money put towards a New Pastor Reception.

The Constitution Review Committee has been formed and the members have been given a copy of Constitution and Bylaws to start reviewing.

New Business

The Call Committee has a meeting with Pastor Mitch Phillips from Synod in September, as he is currently reviewing potential candidates. The Call Committee is planning on having a practice interview during September, with the projection of actual interviews starting in October.

Pastor Laura's contact is coming up in October. Going forward, her contract will be extended on a month to month basis.

The Total Eclipse is happening on April 8, 2024 - discussion took place on how we want to utilize the parking lot and property for this event.

Growing in Faith is a ministry within the ELCA committed to fostering learning environments for followers of Jesus to grow in faith. We believe that lay members of our parishes are integral to healthy discipleship in our churches and communities. Thus, we gather followers across congregations to grow in faith together. Growing in Faith is a series of classes that you can take all in one year or over the course of many years. This Fall, the classes are being offered online through other synods. We will begin offering these courses through our pastors and in person in the Spring. Each course runs for 5 weeks and costs \$65/course. This fee can be covered by the church for those interested. This year (2023-2024) we are offering the following courses via Zoom:

Worship Matters Thursdays from 6-9pm – Sept. 21 Oct. 19 Why do we worship Sunday after Sunday? Is worship intended for an 'in group' to comfort and console? Is worship intended to equip for mission and service? Is worship for God or for us? As we explore these questions, we will discover tensions in worship: a God focus or a communal focus, a head focus or a heart focus, a structured worship or a free worship, a universal church focus or a focus on the local assembly and its needs.

Christianity in a Lutheran Key Thursdays from 6-9pm – Nov. 2 - Dec. 7 (NEW) Tuesdays from 7-10pm - Sept. 12 - Oct. 10 While all Christians share a common set of theological beliefs, Lutherans look at things through a filter of grace. In this course we will discover more about our Lutheran roots. We will also look forward to challenges that face us in the future.

Introduction to the Old Testament Thursdays from 6-9pm – Dec. 14 - Jan. 25 (NEW) Tuesdays from 7-10pm - Oct. 17 - Nov. 21 The aims of this course are to give the students an overview of the structure and theology of the Hebrew Scriptures and present the varieties of forms used to communicate the truth of God's Word contained in them. Special attention will be given to covenant theology and to relating Old Testament theology and history to our understanding of the New Testament.

Introduction to the New Testament – TBD The goals of this course are to understand the gospel message as revealed in the New Testament (NT), to explore the life and faith of the Christian church in the first century, to understand how the Bible came down to us in its present form, and to understand and use a variety of tools for interpreting the Bible. Throughout the course students will reflect on how the New Testament Gospel has shaped our Christian lives.

Lutheran Creeds and Confessions – TBD This course provides an analysis of the historical context and theological content of the Book of Concord (the Lutheran Confessions) with an eye to establishing the importance of its witness for Christian mission and ministry.

Living as a Christian in the World – TBD Students will discuss and explore their role as a member of a Christian community and the community at large. This course allows students to explore their place in a community that is not necessarily predominantly Christian. Begin discernment on future service and ministries in their congregations and communities.
